The Bering 75 is part of the Exploration series. Like all of Bering's models she has been designed from the keel up to be a superb transoceanic yacht. This pilothouse designed motoryacht is perfectly capable of being handled by a crew of two yet her interior layout can easily accommodate up to eight passengers. Her substantial beam measurement allows her to feel larger than one might expect for a yacht of her length. She is a capable and rugged long range passagemaker and with her large stores of fuel and water can easily travel over 4,000 nautical miles without requiring the need for resupply.





The Bering 75's main deck provides full walk around access, a real convenience when performing docking or mooring duties. Above deck, there's plenty of space to spread out and enjoy the ocean views and sea breeze. On the main deck there is a built in settee just forward of the pilothouse. This is a neat use of space that gives you an elevated and unobstructed view looking forward. It's a perfect nook for curling up with a good book or enjoying a sunset and glass of wine with friends and family. The flybridge deck houses the upper steering station as well as a large settee and dining table. There's room for a grill, wet bar, refrigeration, whatever you need to make for the perfect entertaining environment, even if that means a hot tub!





Inside you will find a spacious and well thought out layout. The accompanying layout renderings show just several of the stateroom options available to you. The Bering 75 displaces 350,000 pounds at full load and offers a rare combination of a stunning interior and a beautifully finished hull all packaged into an extremely capable and reliable ocean crossing vessel.
